

Scholarship Program 2022

Eligibility

Aspiring Cape Cod/Island artists who are graduating in 2022 or have graduated from a Cape Cod/Island high school in the past three years plan and plan or will continue to study a visual arts related field at the postsecondary level

Award

The PPSCC grant will include a scholarship of a \$500 gift certificate to purchase art supplies and a set of artist grade pastels. An awards event and pop-up exhibit will be scheduled as dictated by recommended Covid safety measures.

Application Process

- Completed application form
- Recommendation of teacher, counselor, or school administrator
- 5 examples of artwork saved as JPG labeled with applicant's last name and title submitted at 300 dpi and 900 pixels long
- One page applicant statement to include art background and experience and future aspirations to pursue visual arts
- Submit completed application materials electronically by May 1, 2022.

Recipients will be notified by May 11, 2022.
