

2022 Stone Scholarship for PPSCC Members

Eligibility

The program is available for paid PPSCC members with non-professional status (not yet won awards, not signature member of any art society, not yet won art awards and not represented by a gallery). The applicant must be able to demonstrate the potential to benefit from a workshop with an accomplished pastel instructor.

Award

The PPSCC Stone Scholarship would enable the award-winning recipients to participate in one workshop: either a Winter One-day Workshop (two will be awarded) or a two-day Masters Pastel Workshop (offered in the summer and the fall).

Application Process

- Provide 5 examples of artwork.
