

## Scholarship Application 2026

## Eligibility

Aspiring Cape Cod/Island artists who are graduating in 2026 or have graduated from a Cape Cod/Island high school in the past three years and plan to or will continue to study a visual arts related field at the postsecondary level

## Award

The PPSCC grant will include a scholarship of a \$500-\$1000 gift certificate to purchase art supplies and a set of artist grade pastels. Recipients will also be invited to participate in an awards event and pop-up exhibit in partnership with the Cape & Island Art Educators Association at the Cape Cod Museum of Art in May 2026.

#### **Application Process**

- Completed application form
- Recommendation of teacher, counselor, or school administrator
- 5 examples of artwork saved as JPG labeled with applicant's last name and title submitted at 300 dpi and 900 pixels long
- One page applicant statement to include art background and experience and future aspirations to pursue visual arts
- Submit completed application materials electronically by May 1, 2026.
